

How Do I Get a Rabies Tag for My New Dog?

Please follow the instructions below for the county that you live in. You are required by law to have a rabies tag for your dog, so please make sure you register your dog and get the appropriate tag for your county.



For each county, you will need to bring / send the following:

- a copy of the rabies certificate
- a copy of the "Internal Kennel Card" showing the dog was spayed/neutered
- note if you changed the name of the dog on the "Internal Kennel Card"
- a self-addressed, stamped envelope for them to send a rabies tag back to you
